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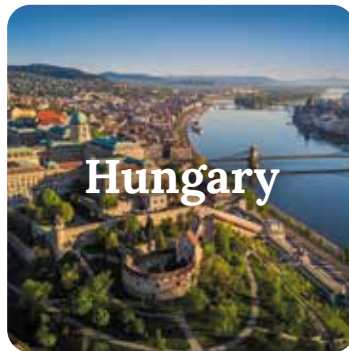

### Most popular options:

**Bike rental:** the best way to explore the surroundings. Available at all our bases (adult and children's sizes, baby seats available on request).

**Barbecue:** enjoy a convivial meal by the water, at lunchtime or in the evening. Available at most bases.

**Wi-Fi device rental:** to help you save your mobile data.

**Final cleaning package:** extend the holiday feeling for a few more hours after your departure.

**Pet package:** your pets are welcome on board, and we ensure thorough cleaning at the end of your stay.

**Navigational guide:** compulsory on board, this detailed map shows currents, navigation zones, mooring points and nearby services (grocery shops, laundries, etc.). If ordered in advance, it can be sent to you by post.

**Grocery delivery on board:** place your order in advance and we'll stock your boat with your shopping before you arrive.



**Paddleboard rental:** available only in Germany, Italy, the Netherlands and Camargue.

**12/220 V converter rental:** required to charge laptops and other 220 V devices from the boat's battery.

**Early check-in / Late return:** available on last-minute request and subject to boat availability.

**Parking:** at certain departure bases, you can reserve a secure, and in some cases covered, parking space for your vehicle.

**Dinghy rental:** available only in Ireland and Italy (dinghies from 3.5 to 4.5 m).

**Taxi transfers:** we can organise transfers from train stations and airports, or back to your departure base if you are on a one-way cruise.

**Car transfer:** your vehicle can be delivered to your arrival base in the case of a one-way cruise.

**Partial Deposit Waiver:** this option allows you to reduce the amount of the security deposit required in case of damage (details: see the General Terms and Conditions).

# Sustainable cruising

Each year, Riverly strengthens its commitment to a more sustainable form of river tourism—one that respects both local communities and the natural environment.

## Lowering emissions



Since 2025, 100% of Riverly's owned fleet (formerly Locaboat and Nicols) has been running on HVO fuel, a hydrotreated vegetable oil that is renewable and biodegradable. This has helped us cut our CO2 emissions by 92%.

Hybrid propulsion By 2026, 39 of our boats use hybrid engines, and since 2018, we also offer two electric boats in Alsace.

## Blue Flag commitment

In 2026, four Riverly bases have earned the Blue Flag certification, a mark of excellence in sustainable tourism..

## Protecting the Canal du Midi

Like Locaboat and Nicols before us, Riverly supports replanting efforts along the Canal du Midi. So far, over 19,000 trees have been replanted.

## Everyday eco-actions

All boats are cleaned with eco-friendly products and equipped with onboard recycling bins. Selective waste collection is available at every base.

## What is the Blue Flag?

Awarded annually, the "Blue Flag" distinguishes beaches and marinas for their high environmental and social standards. In 2024, only 31 river marinas in France were certified, including four Riverly bases: Corbigny, Saintes, Saint-Martin sur Oust and Joigny.

## From Argens or Le Somail

Make a stop in the medieval villages of Tr  bes and Puich  ric, then cruise under the arched bridge of Le Somail, renowned for its basket-handle shape, before reaching this charming village, ranked among the Canal du Midi's most beautiful sites. Further on, take the Canal de la Robine toward Narbonne, once a Roman city.

If you choose to continue your cruise toward the Thau Lagoon, you'll reach the spectacular Fons  ranes Locks, just a short distance from B  ziers—birthplace of Pierre-Paul Riquet, the canal's visionary creator.

## From Lattes

South of Montpellier, Lattes is your gateway to the Canal du Rhône à Sète. Welcome to the Petite Camargue, where nature puts on a spectacular show each day. Along the way, discover Aigues- Mortes, the fortified city of Saint LYess. Further west, make a stop at Mas des Baumelles and continue on to the capital of the Camargue: Les Saintes-Maries-de-la-Mer, with their whitewashed houses. Then cruise up the Petit Rhône and pause in Beaucaire, a town of art and history in the Gard region.



## From Bellegarde

Heading toward Sète, let the channel guide you across the Étang de Thau—a vast inland sea surrounded by rolling hills and quaint harbours. The clear, salty waters are perfect for swimming: drop anchor or pull up near a small beach for a refreshing break in a stunning natural setting. Bouzigues is a must-stop for oyster and shellfish lovers—the local delicacies are farmed right in the lagoon. Further on, stop in Agde, an ancient Greek town known as the “Black Pearl” for its striking volcanic stone buildings.

## From Saintes

With its rich Gallo-Roman heritage, Saintes is the second largest city in the region. From here, cruise from village to village, admiring the red-tiled rooftops and beautiful Romanesque churches in places like Saint-Savinien, Chaniers, and Bourg-Charente.

Make a stop in Saint-Simon, where you can explore the history and heritage of the gabarriers—the traditional riverboatmen. Heading toward Angoulême, you'll arrive in Cognac, the capital of the famous “liqueur of the gods.” Visit its renowned trading houses, elegant mansions, and the historic Récollets convent.

## From Sireuil

Set off from Sireuil, a charming departure point nestled in the heart of the vineyards, and drift along the gentle meanders of the Charente. Stop off at a nearby wine estate for an introductory tasting.

Soon, you'll reach Jarnac, where the grand cognac houses welcome curious visitors, and the flower-lined quays invite you to slow down and stroll.

Angoulême, perched high on its ramparts, is famous for its comic book festival and mural-covered walls. Its lively old town beats to the rhythm of its vibrant cultural life.

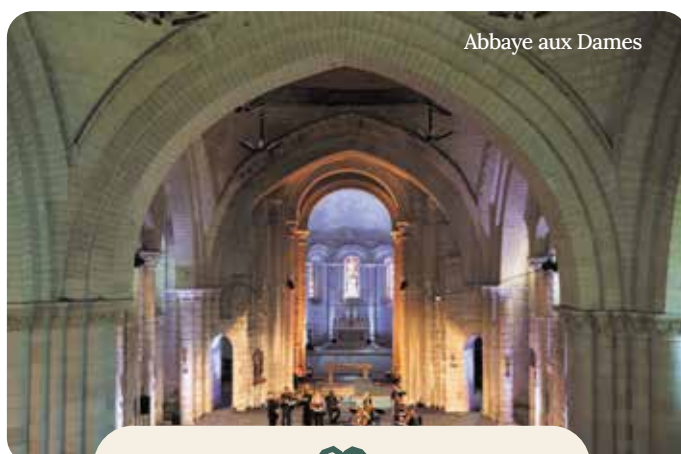

## From Buzet sur Baïse

Set off along the Canal de Garonne toward Agen, the renowned capital of prunes, where 2,000 years of history have left a remarkable heritage. Heading in the direction of Toulouse, discover the 11th-century Abbey of Moissac, famous for its extraordinary Romanesque sculptures.

Along the way, treat yourself to local delights: Lot-et-Garonne tomatoes and strawberries, Armagnac, prunes, duck breast, regional wines...



If you follow the winding course of the Baïse River, you'll discover an entirely different landscape—greener, with wild, unspoiled banks. In Nérac, wander the old streets of the medieval town and pause on the Pont Vieux for a sweeping view of the Tanners' Quarter. In the former episcopal city of Condom, admire the cathedral, its cloister, the Armagnac museum, and the elegant mansions. From the riverbanks, a network of hiking trails invites you to explore the surrounding countryside.

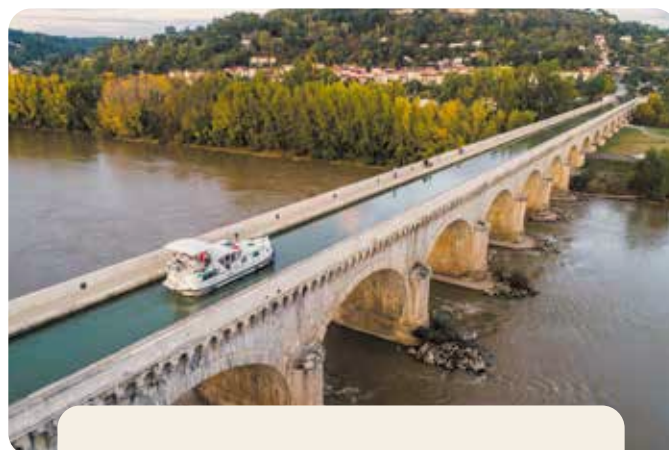

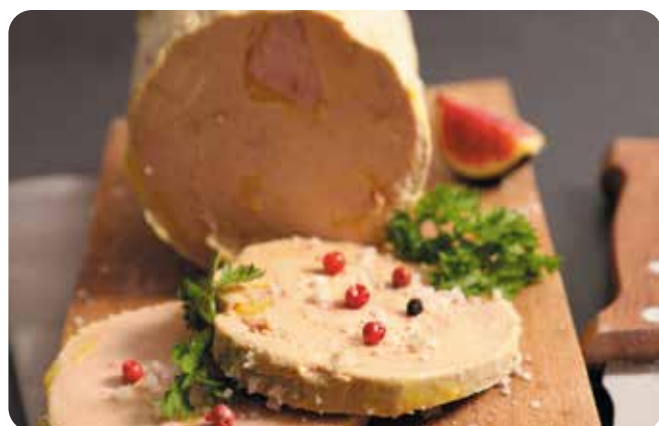

## From Cahors

Begin your journey in Cahors, capital of the Lot region, where southern charm, rich heritage and gourmet delights come together. Labelled a “Town and Land of Art and History,” Cahors appeals equally to heritage lovers and fans of the French art de vivre. A little further on, Saint-Géry nestles at the foot of towering cliffs dotted with natural caves.

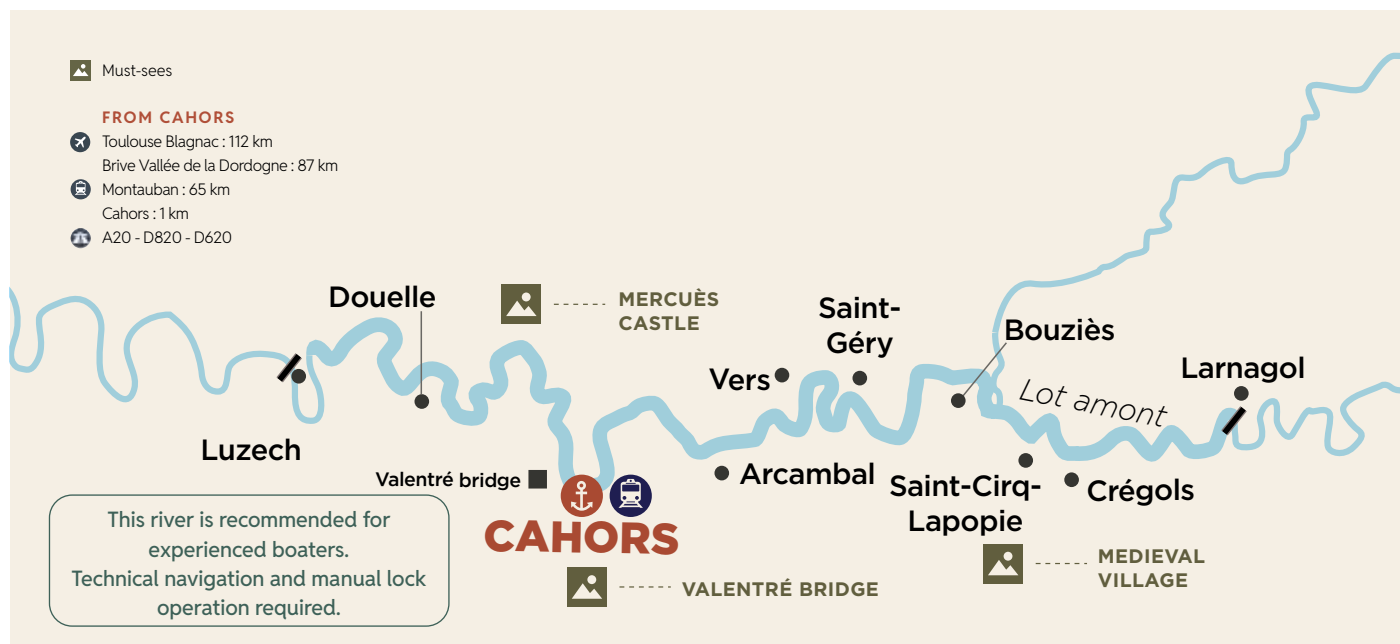

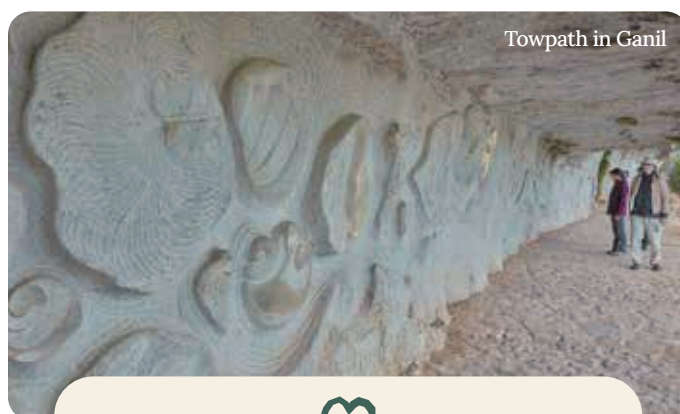
Keep your eyes wide open: thanks to its strategic location, Saint-Cirq-Lapopie offers several breathtaking viewpoints.

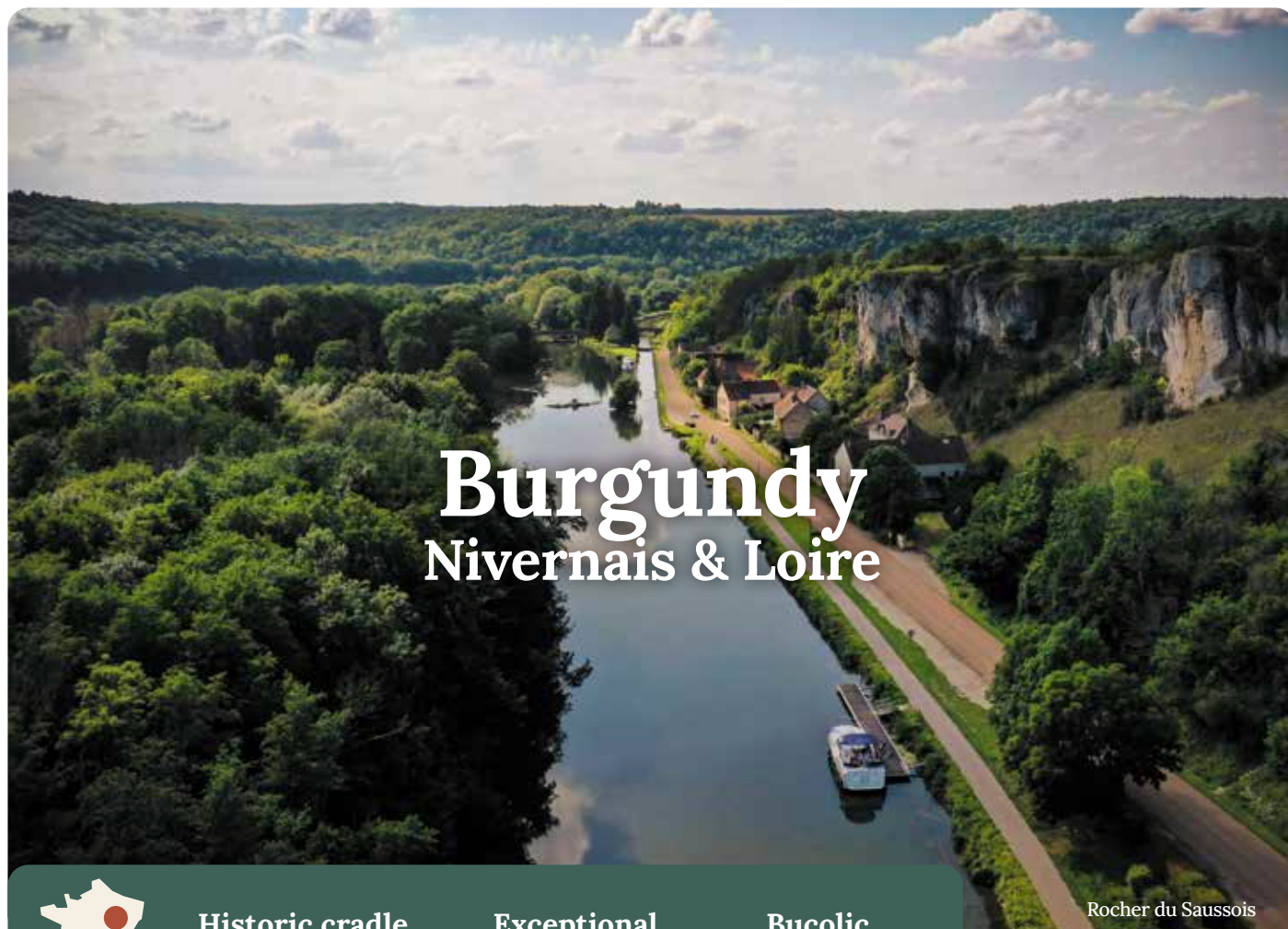

### From Joigny

Located at the crossroads of the Yonne and the Canal de Bourgogne (built in the 18th century), Joigny is the perfect departure point to explore this region rich in heritage and gastronomy. Follow the meanders of the Yonne: landscapes of hedgerow countryside and the Othe forest will guide you to Villeneuve-sur-Yonne, then Sens.

There, you'll discover the splendid Saint-Étienne Cathedral, considered France's first Gothic cathedral. Heading east, you'll reach Auxerre and its famous Chablis and Auxerrois vineyards. Begin your cruise on the Canal du Nivernais, where winemaking villages follow one after another among the vines and churches—like Saint-Bris-le-Vineux and Irancy.



Auxerre

Taking the Canal de Bourgogne, a land of water and forest, reveals some hidden gems. Saint-Florentin is one of them, and its church is a true treasure—featuring remarkable 16th-century sculptures and bas-reliefs, along with 24 stained-glass windows in rare harmony.

Next, stop in Tanlay, where the château stands as one of the finest examples of Renaissance architecture in Burgundy, renowned for its gallery decorated with trompe-l'oeil paintings and frescoes. A little further on, the remarkable Ancy-le-Franc palace welcomes visitors with its exceptional collection of mural paintings.



## From Dompierre sur Besbre

Dompierre opens the doors to countless discoveries. You'll cruise along riverbanks lined with castles, abbeys, and charming villages. In Digoin, your boat will pass from the canal to the Canal du Centre, crossing a 19th-century canal bridge, then heading toward Paray-le-Monial. Let yourself be charmed by the sacred beauty of the basilica and the unique Romanesque architecture of southern Burgundy.

Moor at Diou or Beaulon and take a walk through the alleys of the Abbey of Charolles, a beautiful site nestled among the vineyards.

Once in Decize, nicknamed “the island city,” your journey continues toward the town of La Machine. Each member of the crew will remember the delicious simplicity of a picnic on the grass.

To the north, the Canal Latéral à la Loire leads you to Sancerre, Apremont-sur-Allier and its flower-filled village, and finally Nevers.

Wines from Sancerre and PYeslly-Fumé go perfectly with a little goat cheese—say, Chavignol crottin.

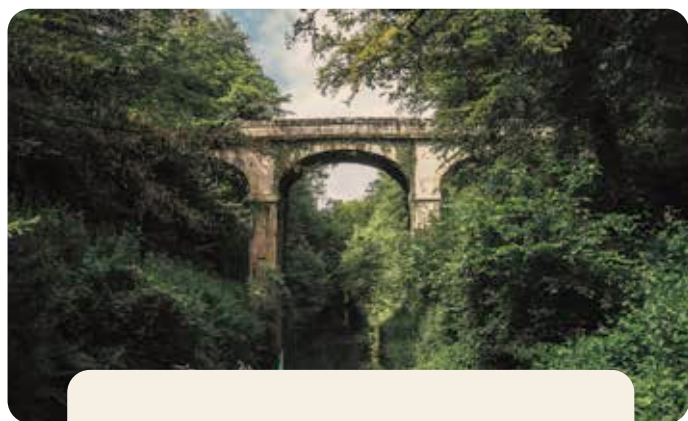
## From Corbigny

The Canal du Nivernais is one of the most beautiful river routes in France. In the town of Sardy-lès-Épiry, a spectacular series of 16 locks carries you up or down a 35 km stretch. The three tunnels at Collancelle follow one another and are unquestionably among the canal's most fascinating features.

For a nature-filled break, stop at Baye Lake, which borders the canal in an exceptional ecological setting. Back on the water: in the distance, you'll spot the silhouette of Châtillon-en-Bazois castle.

If you're heading toward Auxerre, make a stop in Tannay to enjoy an underrated local wine: Coteaux-de-Tannay. Continue to Clamecy and admire the flamboyant Gothic style of the Saint-Martin Collegiate Church.

At Châtel-Censoir, in the heart of the Yonne valley, the Collegiate Church of Saint-Potentien offers a peaceful and scenic stop.



## Did you know?

The Collancelle locks are part of the oldest section of the Nivernais Canal, dating back to the 18th century.

The Collancelle tunnels, dug through the Morvan hills, are a rare engineering feat. They span three consecutive tunnels, with a total length of 758 m, ranging from 268 m to 212 m.

## From Plagny

From Plagny, your cruise begins in the peacefulness of the Loire countryside. The Canal Latéral à la Loire offers stunning open views of the surrounding hillsides and riverside heritage. Admire the medieval town of Nevers and its ducal palace, and don't miss Briare, with its spectacular canal bridge. At Chevenon, a 13th-century castle awaits in the heart of a peaceful hamlet.

You can also enrich your itinerary with a stop in Sancerre. Perched on its rocky spur, the village offers sweeping views over the Loire Valley and its vineyards. To fully enjoy the experience, sample the region's famous goat cheeses with a glass of Chavignol wine—an ideal pairing to wrap up your cruise.

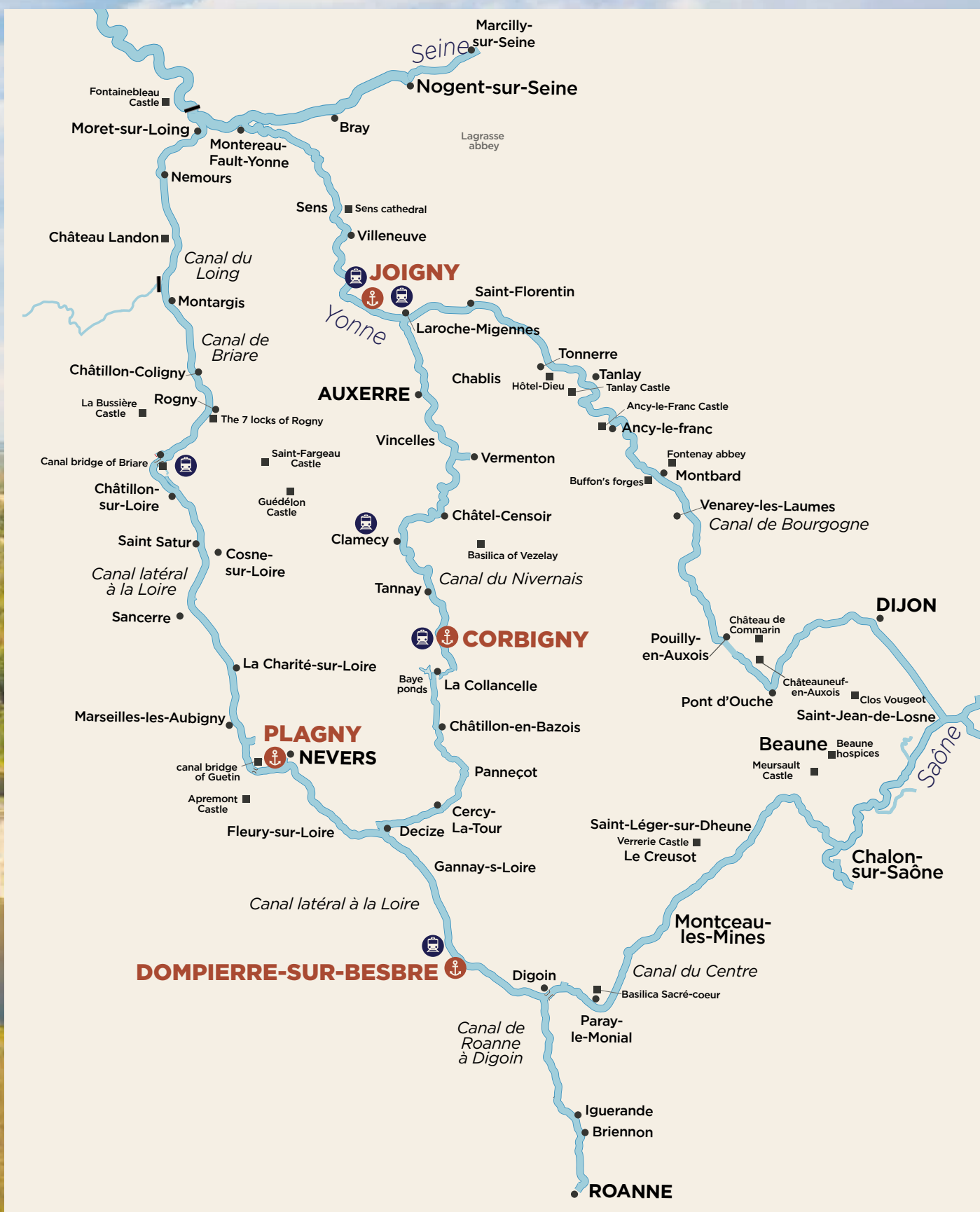

## From Saint-Léger-Sur-Dheune

Heading up the Saône, you'll sail through peaceful pastureland—with Verdun-sur-Doubs as one of the most picturesque stops.

To the south, make your way to Tournus and wander through its maze of charming streets with colourful façades, leading to the Saint-Philibert Abbey, a masterpiece of Romanesque art.

You can then detour onto the Seille, a delightful little river lined with protected areas designated as "Natura 2000" sites.

Along the way, stop in Louhans—officially recognised as a "Remarkable Taste Site"—to sample the famous Bresse poultry.

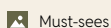

## From Scey-sur-Saône

Heading upstream, stop at Corre—the last sizeable village before the Canal des Vosges. Surrounded by meadows and forests, this peaceful spot is a paradise for fishing, wild swimming, or cycling along the greenway.

Further along, the ruined castle of Fontenoy-le-Château overlooks the valley, while the village centre invites you to take a gentle stroll. Continue on to Épinal—famed for its illustrated prints—where you'll find a lively town centre, landscaped riverbanks, and the iconic Musée de l'Imagerie.

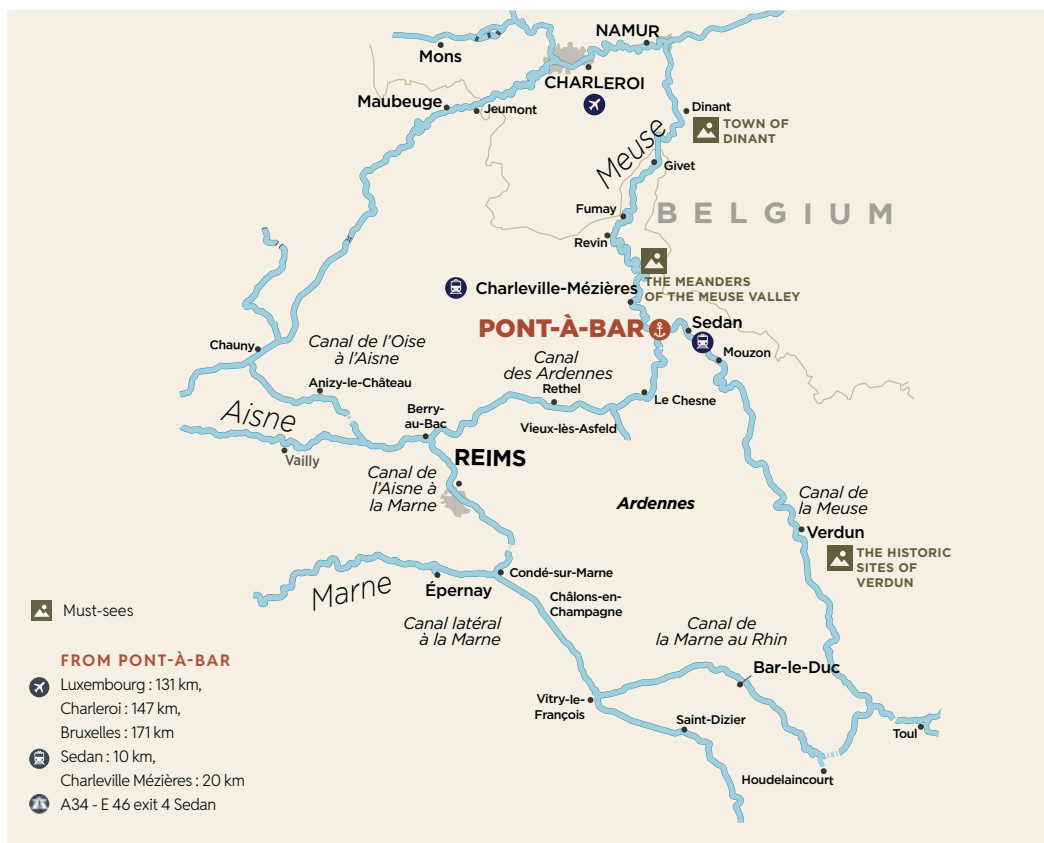
Cruising farther north brings you into Belgium. Make a stop in Dinant, a colourful riverside town at the foot of a cliff, then on to Namur, where you can visit one of its many museums or explore the cobbled streets—on foot or by bike.

To the south, heading toward Reims, the Canal des Ardennes links the Champagne hills to the Meuse. In the lush Montgon Valley, the canal's 26 automatic locks are a joy to navigate, you will feel compelled to stop along the way and admire the peaceful scenery. To the east, between Pont-à-Bar and Verdun, discover the Lorraine stretch of the Meuse Valley.

This 100 km route, with 22 locks, takes you far from major roads and dams, immersing you in pristine natural surroundings. Whether you love fishing or cycling, the possibilities are endless.

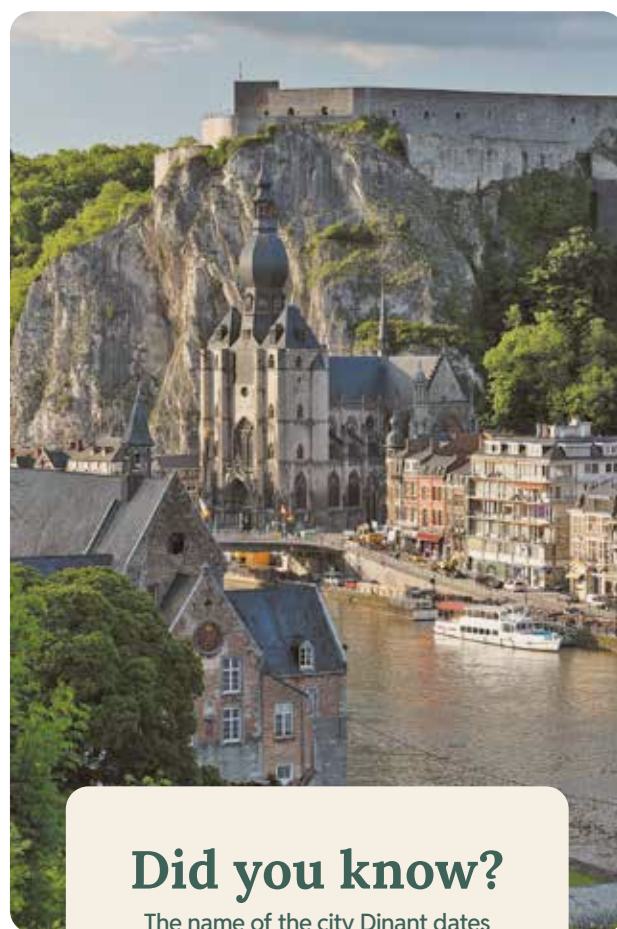

### From Fürstenberg

Set course for Strasen, where scenic hiking trails lead you through lush green forests, past lakes and away from main roads.

A stop in Wesenberg invites you to wander through the Skulpturenpark, a park featuring an open-air sculpture exhibition.

A little further on, let yourself be charmed by the town of Neustrelitz and its Baroque castle.

To the south, stop in Himmelpfort—famous not only as the hometown of Father Christmas, but also for its smoked fish and fishing traditions.

With a detour via Lychen, follow the Woblitz River through forests until you reach the large Lychen lake (Großer Lychensee), one of the most beautiful paddling routes in the region.

At the Regow lock, you might spot beavers and otters. Continue on to Templin to discover major historic sites such as its medieval town centre surrounded by partially preserved fortifications.

From Liebenwalde, take the historic Finow Canal and reach one of Europe's most unique engineering feats: the boat lift at Niederfinow.

If you hold a boating license, you can cruise all the way to the lakes of Neuruppin—true natural oases.

Then take the Oder-Havel Canal to reach Berlin and enjoy panoramic views from the Reichstag to Museum Island, before heading into the vibrant neighbourhoods of Kreuzberg and Prenzlauer Berg.



### From Lübz

From Lübz, you can set sail towards the great lakes of Müritz and Plauer See to the east. These waters will enchant you with their charming towns, such as Plau and Waren. The Stör-Elde waterway will take you to Schwerin, the regional capital, where a fairy-tale castle sits proudly on an island.

We recommend a detour to Dömitz via the Müritz-Elde waterway — a haven for nature lovers and fishing enthusiasts. Let yourself be lulled by nature and bid goodnight to herons and beavers.

# Terms and conditions of hire

Applicable from the 15th of September 2025

## 1. BOOKING FORM AND RENTAL AGREEMENT

This booking form must be duly completed, signed, and returned to the rental company, together with the required payment, before the expiration of the option.

Submission of the signed booking form by the Hirer constitutes full acceptance of the rental terms and conditions, including these general terms and conditions and the specific terms stated in the booking form.

The rental agreement becomes final once the rental company confirms the booking to the Hirer, having received both the signed booking form and the corresponding payment.

## 2. PAYMENT TERMS

A deposit of at least 40% of the total charter fee must be submitted with the booking form. The balance is due no later than six (6) weeks prior to departure, without further reminder from the rental company.

- Failure to comply with the payment schedule or to pay the outstanding balance shall entitle the rental company to cancel the booking.
- Any booking made less within 42 days (6 weeks) of the departure date, must be paid in full at the time of booking.
- All bank charges are to be borne by the Hirer.
- In accordance with Article L 221-28 of the French Consumer Code, the Hirer shall not benefit from the right of withdrawal as set out in Article L 221-18 of the same Code when booking by phone or online with the rental company.

## 3. TYPE OF BOAT BOOKED

The type of boat booked corresponds to a range (Pénichette / Cruiser), a category (Classic, Comfort, Premium or Premium+), and an accommodation capacity. The plans, equipment details, technical information (such as tank capacities, cabin layouts, etc.) presented in the brochure, website, or any other media, are provided as examples and are not contractual.

## 4. BOOKING MODIFICATIONS

Any request by the Hirer to change the booking (including changes to the date, boat, base, or cruising region) is subject to the prior approval of the rental company. Any costs or losses incurred will be entirely borne by the hirer, under the same terms as a cancellation (see §5), with a minimum administrative fee of €150.

## 5. CANCELLATION

**By the Hirer:**

- If the Hirer is forced to cancel the booking, they must notify the rental company in writing. Regardless of the reason for the cancellation, the following fees will apply:
- More than 12 weeks before departure: 15% of the rental amount (with a minimum of €150),
- Between 6 and 12 weeks before departure: 40% of the rental amount (with a minimum of €150),
- Less than 6 weeks before departure: 100% of the rental amount.
- The Hirer may take out a cancellation insurance policy—either through an insurer of their choice or via the rental company—which may cover all or part of the cancellation fees, depending on the terms and coverage of said insurance.

**By the rental company:**

- If, due to circumstances beyond the rental company's control, the rental company is unable to provide the Hirer with the booked boat, he undertakes to make every effort to provide the Hirer with a boat of equivalent comfort and capacity.
- If no suitable alternative can be found within the contractual timeframe, the rental company will refund the rental fee, to the exclusion of any other amount on any grounds whatsoever, and excluding any damages or compensation.
- As a reminder, in case of failure to comply with the payment schedule, the rental company is entitled to cancel the booking (see §2 – Payment Terms).

## 6. YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES

The designated skipper must be at least 18 years old (21 in Hungary if not holding a boating license) and is responsible for the boat, its equipment, the crew, and all onboard individuals.

Only individuals aged 16 or older may operate the boat, under the supervision of a designated adult identified on the navigation card or having received the initial instruction to navigation.

The skipper must be accompanied by at least one other person over 16 years of age for navigation in France, or majority for navigation in other countries ; and physically able to assist with navigation and manoeuvres.

The rental company reserves the right to refuse to hand over the boat if the designated captain does not appear capable of assuming this responsibility, regardless of any references, licenses, or certificates presented; or if the captain is not accompanied by at least one other person over the age of 16. In such cases, the rental company reserves the right either to propose a stationary stay (moored at the dock) or to limit the navigation area for all or part of the rental period; or to refuse to hand over the boat and terminate the contract, in which case no refund of any amount paid shall be made.

## 7. BOAT HANDOVER AND HIRER'S OBLIGATIONS

The skipper will take possession of the boat after completing all formalities (security deposit, inventory), receiving navigation documents, and being informed of the navigation instructions.

The customer reception and the handling of the boat take place between 3 PM and 6 PM on the first day of rental.

The Hirer must comply with all inland waterway regulations and the instructions provided by the rental company and relevant authorities. Night navigation, towing, lending, or subletting the boat is strictly prohibited.

The Hirer is solely liable for any legal consequences, fines, or seizures imposed by the authorities.

The skipper is prohibited from boarding more persons than the authorized number.

## 8. SECURITY DEPOSIT

The security deposit must be paid on the day of departure before boarding and will be refunded at the end of the cruise provided that the boat and all its equipment are returned in good condition, at the agreed time and place, that the boat has neither suffered nor caused damage to any third party, and that all amounts due for the stay or services have been duly paid.

Deposit amounts range from €2,500 to €4,500 depending on the boat size & category.

This security deposit is intended to cover:

- Loss, damage, or destruction of the boat or its equipment, as well as any costs related to refloating, attributable to the Hirer and/or their passengers;
- The cost of replacing any missing (lost or stolen) or damaged items compared to the inventory prepared jointly at the start of the rental period, including optional equipment rented in addition (bicycles, barbecue, Wi-Fi device, etc.);
- Delays in returning the boat (see §16) or costs resulting from abandonment of the boat (see §15);
- The cost of fuel and other consumables (see §10);
- Cleaning fees if the boat is not returned in a perfectly clean condition (€200 per boat) in cases where the Hirer has not purchased the "cleaning package" service.

The Hirer authorizes the rental company to charge these amounts via the pre-authorized bank hold taken as the security deposit.

## 9. INSURANCE

The insurance of the rented boat covers accidental damage to the rented boat or caused to third parties by the boat.

This insurance does not cover: persons on board, their personal belongings, their own third-party liability; loss or damage to equipment or gear; poor maintenance of the boat by the Hirer; bicycles and other equipment rented in addition to the boat (barbecue, Wi-Fi, etc.).

The Hirer remains liable up to the amount of the security deposit and may take out additional insurance to cover:

- Cancellation fees;
- Deposit waiver.

In any case, the insurance will not cover the renter's civil liability, nor any damage, loss, or other expenses resulting, for example, from intentional or gross misconduct, deliberate breach of safety or navigation rules; violation of navigation bans or restrictions, towing operations, acts committed by any crew member while ashore, unlawful or inappropriate use of the boat, its equipment or accessories, operation under the influence of alcohol, drugs, or any substances—including medication—that impair awareness or reaction time, use of the boat for purposes other than personal leisure, exceeding the maximum number of authorized passengers as defined by the rental company, navigation outside permitted zones, at night, or in winds exceeding Force 3 on the Beaufort scale, false declarations, as well as any malicious acts committed with the complicity of any person on board.

## 10. FUEL, CONSUMABLES AND MOORING FEES

The Hirer is responsible for the cost of fuel, lubricants, kitchen gas, and all consumables necessary for boat operation and maintenance during the rental period. Prices are based on the rental company's published rates and may vary with market conditions. Any mooring fees or parking charges are the responsibility of the Hirer and depend on the chosen stopover locations.

## 11. ONE-WAY TRIPS

Even when accepted by the rental company, one-way trips are not guaranteed and may be changed due to operational constraints. Therefore, the directions of one-way trips, and thus the boarding locations within the same region, may be swapped. Similarly, a one-way cruise may have to be converted into a round trip, all for reasons beyond the rental company's control. In the latter case, only additional one-way costs will be reimbursed. The Hirer must call the base 48 hours prior to boarding to confirm the trip direction and location. In such a case only one-way trip surcharges will be refunded. No compensation or cancellation will be granted.

## 12. NAVIGATION RESTRICTIONS AND INTERRUPTIONS

Only the boarding and return locations are contractual (except as provided in §11); the cruising itinerary is not. The rental company cannot be held liable or required to provide compensation in the event of navigation interruptions or restrictions due to circumstances beyond its control, such as construction works, flooding, drought or other adverse weather conditions, strikes, administrative directives, lock breakdowns or closures, and similar situations. If these events make the cruise impossible, the rental company may propose new dates or alternative boarding / disembarkation points with an equivalent or upgraded boat ; or amounts paid may be credited toward a future booking to be agreed upon by the parties. Failing that, they will be retained by the rental company. If events occur during the cruise that lead to the total interruption of navigation and the loss of one or more days, the amounts paid may be applied to a future trip, only on the same base and in the same season. Otherwise, the rental company is not obligated to refund, and the amounts paid will be retained.

## 13. BREAKDOWNS

The rental company provides the Hirer with an assistance service in case of breakdown or damage; this service will intervene as soon as possible after becoming aware of the issue, during working hours, 7 days a week. This service is free unless the Hirer is at fault.

In all cases, the Hirer shall refrain from any action not required by the urgency of ensuring the safety of the boat and/or its crew.

**Breakdowns not attributable to the Hirer :** if the boat is immobilized for more than 24 hours, the rental company will refund the rental on a prorated basis for time lost, excluding any other compensation. The duration of immobilization is counted from the moment the Hirer informed the rental company of the existence of the breakdown.

**Breakdowns attributable to the Hirer :** If the breakdown of the boat is attributable to the Hirer, they shall not be entitled to any compensation for loss of use of the boat. The rental company reserves the right to withhold all or part of the security deposit to cover the costs of repairing the boat.

## 14. DAMAGE / ACCIDENTS

The Hirer must immediately report any accident to the rental company by phone, who will then provide instructions on the steps to follow.

The Hirer must not carry out or arrange for any repairs to the boat without the prior consent of the rental company.

The Hirer must complete an accident report and have it signed by all involved parties and potential witnesses.

Any incident not attributable to the rental company shall not give rise to any claim or compensation in favor of the Hirer, whether they are responsible for or a victim of the accident, in the event that their cruise is affected and/or interrupted as a result.

## 15. BOAT'S DESERTION

If the Hirer abandons the boat, except in cases of sudden and lengthy impracticability of the waterway, they will be charged a repatriation fee of **€200** per day, in addition to fuel and cleaning costs.

## 16. RETURNING THE BOAT

The boat must be returned at the agreed location, date, and time (between 8 and 9 AM) : the skipper must allow sufficient margin to respect the return time. The boat must be returned in the same condition and cleanliness as at check-in. If cleaning service was purchased, the Hirer must still remove trash, clean and store dishes, and strip bed linens. The Hirer shall be responsible for all expenses resulting from any delay caused by them. Each commenced day of delay shall entitle the rental company to compensation equal to the daily rental rate, plus any additional costs the rental company may incur in compensating the next Hirer.

## 17. COMPLAINTS AND MEDIATION

If assistance is needed during the cruise, the Hirer must immediately notify the base for resolution. Unresolved issues may be submitted in writing to the reservations team within 60 days of the cruise end date. The request must include the booking number and all relevant details. Only complaints for which the issue was reported to the base at the time of occurrence will be considered.

## 18. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

This rental contract is governed by French law. The rental company is not subject to the European Directive (EU) 2015/2302 on package travel as only the boat hire service is provided. The rental company operates under independent contracts with each affiliated base and assumes no liability for their execution of rental services, each affiliate being an independent rental company.

## 19. PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION

In accordance with the French Data Protection Act No. 78-17 of 6 January 1978 and the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2016/679, you have the right to access, rectify, limit, and delete your personal data. The rental company privacy policy is available on their website and can be provided upon request.
